Hotel dei Cavalieri Milano Duomo is conveniently located in Piazza Giuseppe Missori, 1, just 200 meters from Piazza Duomo. The hotel is easily accessible via public transport, with the Missori metro station (M3 line) and the 12, 15, 16, 24 trams nearby. Linate Airport is connected to Milan city centre by the M4 underground line. From Linate Airport take the M4 line and get off at the Sforza Policlinico stop. The hotel is about 5 minutes' walk from Sforza Policlinico. Taxis are readily available from the Linate airport or Milan Central station, with an estimated travel time of 25 minutes. The distance from Malpensa Airport is of about 50 minutes by car and 1h 10 minutes by train shuttle.
